

RULES FOR THE OPERATION AND USE OF THE CEDAR LAKE YACHT CLUB AND SOUTH LAKE SAILING SCHOOL BUILDING, EQUIPMENT, GROUNDS AND FACILITIES

1. **Deportment:** Members are responsible for their own acts, as well as their family and guests. It is expected the members and their guests use discretion concerning their conduct and language while on Club premises.
2. **Guest Privileges:** Non-members may be guests at the Club no more than (8) times per year. This applies to all Club sanctioned events, including club racing events and regattas. (Guest must be signed in)
3. **Responsibility:** All Club facilities are to be kept locked when not in use or unattended, even when member is out sailing.
4. **Compliance:** The Cedar Lake Yacht Club shall be operated in full compliance with the Local and State Laws of Indiana
5. **Club and Sailing Property:** Nothing is to be removed from the clubhouse, grounds or storage barn without prior written approval of the Board of Directors. Members will be held fully responsible for any damage done by themselves or their guest to the club and/or sailing school property and/or equipment.
6. **Pets:** No pets (DOGS, CATS, etc.) are permitted on Club grounds or in the clubhouse.
7. **Alcoholic Beverages:** Members and guests are not permitted to bring to, or dispense alcoholic beverages of any kind on the Club grounds, buildings or facilities. All such beverages must be dispensed from Club bar.
8. **Bar Prices:** Prices for all items served at the bar shall be determined by the board of directors.
9. **Payment at the Bar:** All items served at the bar will be charged to the member's account, drink tickets will be accepted as well as credit cards. Cash is not a method of payment.
10. **Charge Privileges:** Non-members do not have charge privileges. Only those members who are in good standing shall have charge Privileges.
11. **Credit:** Credit is extended to Regular, Social/Boater, Associate, Honorary, Life and Service members of the Club on the following basis:
 - a. Member(s) are billed for charges made by them once per month, with payment due in 30 days of billing date.
 - b. Member(s) who do not pay such bill in 60 days shall be considered to have delinquent accounts, lose their entry code and accordingly, not only may the Board post these names, but further, names will be kept on file with the bartenders to deny any and all charge privileges to these member(s)
 - c. Member(s) who have not paid their bills in 90 days and have made no attempts to settle their indebtedness to the Club may have their membership terminated at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
12. **Tipping:** NO TIPPING
13. **Children in the Bar:** No one under the age of 21 is allowed in the upstairs bar area of the clubhouse. This is in compliance with Indiana State Law. (See rule #4)
